Ski Trips 2008



BELLEAYRE MOUNTAIN, NEW YORK January 11 to 13, 2008

Forget about the snow conditions in January 2007. We're hoping that conditions in 2008 are just as great as 2006, and that's why we are returning to Belleayre Mountain. Its high base elevation means Belleayre gets more natural snow than other areas in the Catskills and with its northeastern exposure the snow holds longer. With the peak at 3,429', vertical drop of 1,404' and 92% snowmaking, we should have a great time on 35 trails. The slope difficulty ranges from 23 % beginners, to 54% intermediate and 23% expert. Belleayre has 7 lifts, 4 lodges, and the slope layout uniquely divides skier's ability. We will be staying at the Colonial Inn and Restaurant in Pine Hill, NY just about two miles from the ski area. The "rustic" family style inn was built in 1870 and is a story in itself. Trip cost includes 2 nights lodging (two double beds, private bath), 2 day lift tickets, 2 full breakfasts, Saturday night dinner buffet, and room taxes. Trip cost is \$220pp/do, \$210pp/to, \$200pp/qo, and \$300 for singles. Non-skiers and (non-boarders) can deduct \$68. We're offering \$10pp off for early signups to the first 15 skiers. We only have 8 rooms reserved. Contact Rick Resh (Phone: 767-5951) for more details. A \$75 deposit will hold your space.

Whistler Blackcomb has been on our radar for a few years and in 2008, we will converge on that "blip" next February! Be ready for plenty of skiing with 8200 acres and nearly a mile of vertical between the two mountains.

SUGARLOAF USA/SUNDAY RIVER, ME
March 26 - 30, 2008

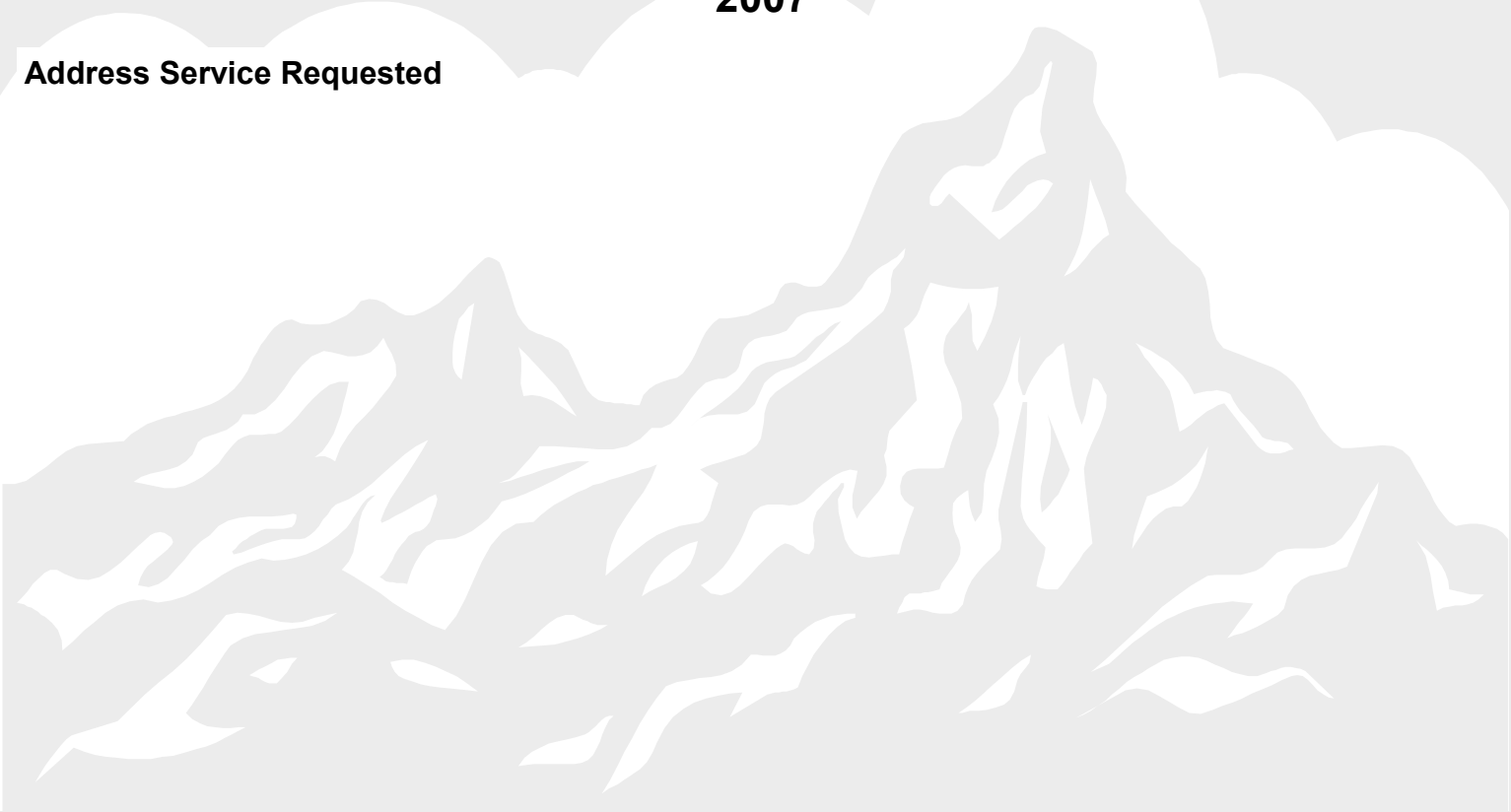


We've resurrected the Spring Fling trip and are adding a new destination. Sugarloaf has the only lift served above treeline skiing in the East. The Loaf has an elevation of 4,237', a vertical drop of 2,820', 1,400 skiable acres and 133 trails and glades. Sunday River is spread out over 8 mountains with a vertical drop of 2,340', 660 acres and 127 trails. We will be staying at the Colonial Valley Motel in Farmington, ME , about a 1/2 hour from Sugarloaf and one hour from Sunday River. Trip cost includes 4 nights lodging (two double beds, private bath), 3 day interchangeable lift ticket and room taxes. There are no meals provided. We plan to ski 2 days at Sugarloaf and the middle day at Sunday River. Trip cost is \$305pp/do, \$270pp/to, \$250pp/qo and \$395 for singles. Contact Rick Resh (Phone: 767-5951) for more details. A \$100.00 deposit will reserve your spot.
