Dear Ski Bums,



Go through stop sign to parking lot on left or park on grass along the road.

Windham Mountain

Car Pool Trip

January 5-6

This year's carpool trip is to Windham Mountain. Accommodations include lodging Friday and Saturday nights at the Windwood Inn, and skiing Saturday and Sunday. A hearty continental breakfast is included in the stay package along with a two-day lift ticket. Extended stay options are available for those interested.

A shuttle bus will provide transportation to and from the mountain. The mountain boasts a vertical rise of 1,600 feet with a 2 mile long trail called the Wonderer. In addition to skiing and snowboarding, Windham offers snow tubing, ice skating, XC skiing and snowshoeing.

Windham is once again offering a "Ski Club Card" that entitles you to a lift ticket for \$25 dollars that can be used the Friday before check in.

Trip pricing is -\$275.00 pp double occupancy. As always, arrangements can be made for early arrivals and those wishing to rent equipment. To ensure your spot, a deposit of \$100.00 pp will reserve your space. (Ok to pay at picnic or 1st meeting) The second payment of \$100.00 pp is due by October 16, 2012. The balance and final payment is due by November 20, 2012.

BLUE MOUNTAIN DAY TRIP

Blue Mountain is big enough to offer something for everyone. With its 39 trails, they have increased chairlift capacity and mastered the art of snow making. For the skiers/boarders with a riskier appetite, "Blue" offers terrain parks, a snow cross trail with banked turns, and plenty of trails to meet your needs.

Blue Mountain is fun for the whole family. Even the diehard "Big Dogs" will get a thrill from their lightning-speed tubing runs. They have family sized tubes and solo tubes...Their tubing hill offers 3 lifts and 21 slides...Describing the tubing hill reminds me of a quote from "Smokey and the Bandit", when Jerry Reed said to the basset hound, "Hang on to your *** Fred"

If that is not enough, "Blue" offers a "Big Air Bag" for those who have ice in their veins. The Big Air Bag will be open on Sunday's from 11a-8p---at an additional cost of \$25(not included in our club package).
