## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

### Transition to New YSC Leadership

On May 31, 2018, Richard Resh tendered his resignation as the York Ski Club President. Effective June 1, 2018, Mike Oberdick, the First Vice President, will assume the vacated office until July 1, 2018. As one of my last unofficial duties, on April 17, 2018, I issued numerous pardons. If you missed that YSC meeting, the list of Presidential Pardons is in this newsletter. Please remember these pardons only provide relief for past indiscretions, not future events or activities.

The new officers elected on February 20, 2018, officially take office on July 1, 2018, but I plan to attend several future Board meetings to help make a smooth transition. Updates are in progress and previous newsletters have been posted.

At the last YSC Board Meeting it was decided to drop the Big Sky, MT trip in 2019. There is no bus trip scheduled for next year. Kirk Lesser is exploring open seating options with clubs in the Blue Ridge Ski Council. The following 2019 trip destinations in the planning stages and final pricing should be available by the YSC picnic:

#### YSC Trips

- Timberline/Canaan, WV 02/14 to 02/18/19
- Salt Lake City, UT 03/02 to 03/09/19

#### EPSC Trips

- Mt. Bachelor, OR 01/26 to 02/01/19
- Attitash/Wildcat, NH 02/28 to 03/03/19

YSC will not be taking the lead on any EPSC trips. Signups for Mt. Bachelor EPSC Trip can be arranged though the Merck Ski Association who will have a pickup for YSC and LSC members at the Eden Resorts in Lancaster. Our Timberline/Canaan, WV trip is about one third full. The Utah trip dates have been confirmed (3/2 to 3/9/19) and the tentative cost of the trip is approx. \$1400 per person. We hope to finalize the details on all trips by the July 15, 2018 YSC Annual Picnic. Another 01/11 to 01/13/19 weekend trip to Belleayre, NY may be added. ### **Rescheduled for Saturday, June 30, 2018**

The York Ski Club bike ride on May 19, 2018 was cancelled due to inclement weather. The YSC bicycle ride on the York County Rail Trail has been rescheduled for Saturday, June 30, 2018. We will leave promptly at 10:15 a.m. from the Seven Valleys Parking lot off Church Street (SR214). There are restroom facilities at Hanover Junction about 10 minutes into the ride.

We plan to ride about 60 to 75+ minutes south to New Freedom Rail Station (with restrooms). On the return trip, we will be stopping at the Four Springs Winery (50 Main Street) in Seven Valleys around 12:30 p.m. for wine tasting. We will be “tailgating” in the parking lot behind the winery. Parking is limited, so please carpool to reduce the number of tailgates on site. All alcohol consumed on the site must be purchased from the winery. The York Ski Club will provide tables and paper products. Guests should bring chairs and a covered dish to share with others. The club will provide several varieties of subs and bottled water,

## Canaan Valley, WV

February 14-18, 2019

Deposits are now being accepted for a car pool trip to Canaan Valley, WV. The trip is capped at 24 members. A \$100 pp deposit will reserve your spot. Trip details have not been finalized, but this trip is likely to fill up fast- so don't be a loser, jump on the bus early.

### SUMMARY OF EVENTS

- Members will depart Thursday, February 14, 2019 and return Monday, February 18, 2019.
- Thursday: The trip will include a side trip to Wisp Mountain, Garrett County, MD in route to Canaan Valley.
- Friday: Ski Timberline Mountain, followed by a Pizza Party that evening
- Saturday: members will have two options:
  - 1) Adventure Ski Tour connecting Canaan Valley Ski Resort to Whitegrass Ski Area (weather permitting); OR,

## YORK SKI CLUB PRESIDENTIAL PARDONS

*I, Richard Gerrard Resh, being duly elected as President of the York Ski Club, Inc., hereby invoke my executive privileges and issue the following Presidential Pardons prior to the termination of my position to the following:*

## DIRECTIONS TO YORK SKI CLUB PICNIC

### From York via Davidsburg Rd.

- Travel west on Davidsburg Road to Rt. 194
- Turn right on Rt. 194 and go approx. 2 miles
- Turn left onto Lake Meade Road and proceed about a mile
- Turn left onto Stoney Point Rd and proceed about 3/4 of mile
- Turn right into the Lake Meade Complex

### From York via East Berlin

- Travel west through East Berlin on Rt. 234 and turn right onto Germany Rd.
- Travel approximately 1 mile on Germany Rd to stop sign
- Make right at stop sign onto Stoney Point Rd and travel approx. 2 miles
- Turn left into Lake Meade complex

### From York via US 30 West

- turn right onto Lake Rd. in Thomasville toward East Berlin
- Turn left onto East Berlin Rd. go through East Berlin
- Turn right onto Germany Rd. and travel approx. 1 mile to stop sign
- Make right at stop sign onto Stoney Point Rd and travel approx. 2 miles
- Turn left into Lake Meade complex

### Once Inside Lake Meade (you are going to the Lake Meade Community Complex ballfield Picnic Area)

- After entering though the Lake Meade gate, continue forward to the tee intersection
- Make a left onto Lake Meade Dr. and go approx. 2 miles to stop sign at Fire House
- At Fire House stop sign, go straight forward (Longstreet) and complex/parking lot is on the left for the picnic

In addition, and to the fullest extent allowed by law, I agree I will not institute any lawsuit or other legal action against the Club, its members, officers, directors, delegates, instructors, agents, employees, representatives, servants, or assigns, as a results of my participation or injury at any Club-related activity. Nor will I voluntarily assist anyone else in the pursuit of any such lawsuit or other legal action.

I also agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Club, its members, officers, directors, delegates, instructors, agents, employees, representatives, servants, or assigns from and against any and all claims, actions, suits, judgements, damages, and costs, including reasonable attorney's fees, that may results by reason of any suit or other legal action I either commence or assist with as described in the preceding paragraph. This Release and Indemnification Agreement shall bind me, my heirs, executors, representatives, successors, and assigns.

I understand and acknowledge that the Club is acting in reliance upon the agreements made by me in this Release and Indemnification Agreement in order to extend to me, the benefits of membership in the Club and were I not willing to abide by the terms of this document, such membership and opportunity to participate in Club-related activities would not be extended to me.
